





Hilary's Story


On July 4, 2022, 12-year-old Hilary was traumatized while attending the Highland Park parade, where she witnessed a mass shooting. The experience left her deeply fearful, avoiding public spaces, wearing noise-canceling headphones, and struggling to function outside of school.

With the help of John, a Josselyn clinician specializing in Eye Movement Desensitization and Reprocessing (EMDR), Hilary began to understand her trauma response and gradually regain control of her life.

Through therapy, she learned how her brain processes fear and discovered that she tends to freeze under stress. Thanks to her work at Josselyn, Hilary is now on a strong path to healing and hope.

Social Emotional Learning Consultant Program has served 600+ students




